The ACT Churches' Council requires a person for a 3 year position, subject to review, to develop the administration, public relations and fundraising processes required for the marketing and maintenance of Christian Religious Education (CRE) in ACT government primary schools. This position will involve liaison with the existing CRE Coordinator, schools, churches and individuals, as well as sessions and guidance from Capacity Builders (a strategic planning organisation). Applicants must be a person of Christian faith with demonstrated administration, communication and fundraising skills. The position is expected to be approximately 32 hours per week with a remuneration package of \$52,000 pa.
